83rd CCM Online Meeting-Endorsement status

Comments Thank you to the CCM members for their active participation in the e-conference and for their prompt response, and I wish you all the best of luck! Although the global outbreak of COVID-19 has been reported in Mongolia for some time, I would like to thank the Ministry of Health, the World Health Organization and the Government for taking all necessary measures. At this time, the Ministry of Health, the main recipient of the current Global Fund funding, is making possible estimates and supporting the redevelopment proposal. The following are some suggestions for redevelopment. These include: 1. To provide N95 masks and other protective equipment for doctors and medical staff, to pay special attention to increase the reserve, and to spend funds; 2. Ensure that equipment and other funding requests meet the requirements of the Global Fund 11 respirators from the Ministry of Health (price 38.5 million MNT each) for a total of 423,500,000 MNT; A total of MNT 53,640,000 was requested for disinfectants. Please send a request to the Golbal Foundation to turn the financing of the disinfectant into a "surgical mask" for health workers, as the Ministry of Health will receive 400 million MNT worth of disinfectants. In other words, 11 respirators and a mask for the remaining 53 million MNT are needed. See from attached Letter #1 The request is supported. There are additional suggestions. The Global Fund's branch office is proposing to provide recipients with disinfectants and hand sanitizers. It is hoped that the main host and the CCM will address this issue. Note: I agree with P.Nyampurev / Youth Health Center NGO /. I support the two proposals submitted to the Ministry of Health. However, it is suggested that not only doctors and medical staff, but also employees of other organizations working in the hotspot (GASI, Ulaanbaatar Specialized Inspection Agency, police, etc.) should be provided with masks and other protective equipment.

The amount of the exchange rate difference supports the implementation of COVID19.

Suggestion: The Global Fund-supported projects in Mongolia need to re-include the provision of disinfection to host organizations and the provision of the necessary masks and hand sanitizers. These organizations play an important role in the successful implementation of the Global Fund project in Mongolia. If necessary, it is the primary recipient's and CCM's responsibility to provide the primary recipient organizations with COVID19 prevention aids and to pay particular attention to human health and safety. Please study the relevant work according to the above suggestions and respond within 24 days.
